



Richfield Historical Society 2024 Maple Syrup Contest Rules

1. You need not be present to win.
2. All entries must include a completed entry form, a one pint (16 oz.) sample of syrup and \$10 entry fee payable to Richfield Historical Society. Syrup must be received by the end of day Monday March 18th, 2024. No entries accepted after that date.
3. Entries become the property of Richfield Historical Society.
4. Only one entry per person or sugar bush.
5. Entries will be placed in uniform glass containers with randomized numbers to keep entries anonymous during the tasting portion. Celebrity judges will rate flavor at Maple Syrup Family Day.
6. Winners will be determined based on a final score of all categories including density, clarity, flavor, color, and container/label.
7. To gain full points for labeling, container label should meet retail labeling requirements to include:
 - a. Name
 - b. Address or PO Box, City, State, Zip Code
 - c. Contents stated as 16 fl. oz (473ml) on lower third of label.
 - d. Front panel should state Pure Maple Syrup and Grade A in the upper half of the label.
 - e. Bottle should have a tamper resistant neck band or safety seal.
8. Winners will be awarded ribbons at the annual RHS Maple Syrup Family Day held on Saturday March 23, 2024 from 9am to 4pm.
