

**Richfield Historical Society  
Historical Park Reservation  
Rules and Regulations**

1. Historical Park must be rented no less than two weeks in advance. All rentals shall be approved by the Richfield Historical Society.
2. Rental fee will be based on number of persons in attendance: \$50 for groups up to 25, \$75 for groups up to 100. For larger groups, contact person listed in #14.
3. **LIMITED** parking is available.
4. Deposit equal to rental fee is required. Deposit will be returned within two weeks if park is left in good condition.
5. No access to buildings is available unless arranged with the Richfield Historical Society in advance with the exception of the horse shed located near the driveway. There will be an additional charge if tours of the buildings are desired. Buildings are outfitted with security systems.
6. Electricity is available on pedestals located south of the mill, west of the mill, on the house, and inside the horse shed.
7. One port-a-potty is located in the park from May through December. You are responsible for obtaining and paying for additional port-a-potties and/or sinks.
8. Park is available from dawn to 10:00 p.m for events. There are no lights. According to village regulations, the park must be vacated by 10:00 p.m.
9. Water is not available. Water from the pump located near the house is not safe for human consumption.
10. Dumpster is available for your use and all refuse should be bagged and placed in it.
11. No alcohol is allowed on the property without first obtaining a permit from the Village of Richfield.
12. No camping or campfires are permitted. Due to the historical significance of the buildings, smoking is not permitted on any of the park grounds.
